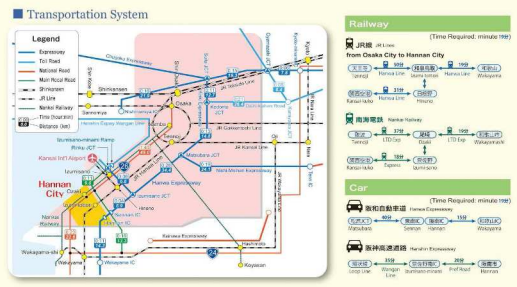

Highlights of the Seasons



Yamanakadani

The atmospheric Kishū Kaidō highway is lined with cherry blossoms in spring. They are illuminated at night, enveloping visitors in a magical scene! The weeping cherry trees at Jifuku-ryō are especially worth seeing. Don't miss the hydrangea flowers and fireflies in early summer too.

Seashell Digging

Sennan Satoumi Park
This fun park has playground equipment and a Wampaku fortress at the top of the mountain with superb views, grassy fields, a barbecue corner, and a giant roller slide.

On the final day of the Yagura festival (national holiday), the portable shrines are carried from Hata Shrine to Sports Beach in Ozaki.

At the Hannan Cotton Farm, created to help revitalize the local community, plants are sown in spring, flower in summer, and in autumn produce fluffy white cotton, making a beautiful landscape.



Hakotsukuri Beach

White beaches and beautiful scenery, right here in Osaka, out in the sea find Kansai Airport and airplanes, and beyond them, look out on Awaji Island and the Akashi Kaikyo Bridge. Easily accessed by train and automobile.

Sennan Satoumi Park

This 2km long, narrow prefecture-run park spans between Hannan City and Misaki. Satoumi is a term that refers to the symbiotic relationship between people and the sea. Walk through the natural grounds, or play beach sports in the sea breeze. Regular events are also held here year-round.



Ginnomine and Kisen Alps Hiking Course

Enjoy the large natural forest areas and the many faces of the seasons. The only mountain system near a beach in Osaka prefecture. See views of Osaka Bay and the Akashi Kaikyo Bridge. Awaji Island and Kansai Airport from everywhere. Turn your eyes southwards and see Wakayama plains.

Brewing Sake (Naniwa Sake Brewery)

The artistic log building interior is the best part. (Tours available on weekends and holidays / minimum 10 people / reservations required)

Wakame

Wakame grown in Osaka bay has plenty of rich flavor. In addition to being healthy, useful for miso soup, sunomono, sashimi, and more.

Nature and history walk with fresh sea air

Hama-kaidō Course

Take a stroll along the old road by the Nankai Railway line. The train stations are always nearby so it's easy to choose a section that suits your interest. There's a lot to see: shrines and temples, old streets, and nature!

Seaweed
Nori seaweed is cultivated in Hannan City's ocean, and it's an excellent product with a firm texture.

Around Ozaki Course

Pass through the streetscape and the scene changes to an old-fashioned fishing port. Look out at the airplanes, and enjoy a picnic or snack around with crabs and plants on the tidal flats.

Izumi's best-known treat, "Murasame"
Made of just azuki beans, rice flour, and sugar. No colorings, additives, or preservatives are used. The azuki beans are carefully washed to remove bitterness for this handmade delicacy.

Ozaki-Izumi Tottori Course

This course where Nankai Railways meets the JR Hanwa Line has great accessibility.

Tour the shrines and temples as well as important cultural properties on this course. Famous local stone, Izumi Sandstone can be found as stone lanterns on the grounds of places like Daigan Temple and Hata Shrine.

Tsujijimo's 'Osaki'
These snacks are made the old-fashioned way by skilled craftsmen who know how to bring out the flavor in the ingredients. Enjoy many varieties. From the simple maki-yaki to chawan (hot crested fish) sashimi flavor.

But wait, there's more!

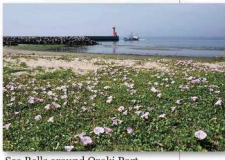
The blessings of the sea can be found in fresh and processed seafood. In Italian, mizu-nasu eggplant is synonymous with the Sannō region. Picked mizu-nasu is famous nationwide. Naniwa-shūzō makes a unique sake with the waters from the Izumi mountains, and the sake brewery is a registered cultural asset.

Special Product
Inkanago Kuguni
Local sand lance fish are used to make this addictive handmade snack.

Izumi Octopus
Osaka Bay has plenty of octopus food and it's very cute, resulting in soft, tasty octopus meat.

Mizu-nasu (eggplant)
This round eggplant is a specialty of Sannō. The skin is soft, and the flesh is so juicy that water can be squeezed out of it with your bare hands. Pickles made from these eggplants are famous nationwide.

Washi Cloth
The light and smooth qualities of wash are combined with the gentle texture of cotton to create wash cloth, which is ideal for washing clothing.

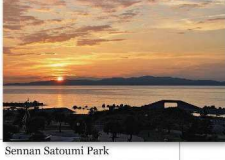

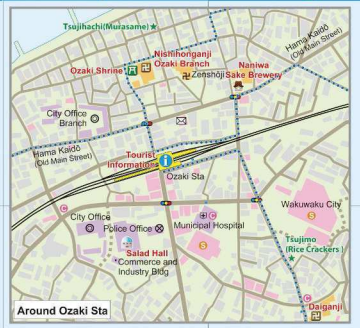
